# Saint Report

Your report should give a brief overview of your saint's life, from birth to death. Refer to the notes you took during the in-class brainstorm to help you decide what kind of information to look for. You also need to include information about when and how he or she became a saint. As you organize your notes to write your report, it will be important to include a paragraph of introduction and another one of conclusion. Each paragraph in your report should be about one main idea, and the paragraphs should be organized into a logical sequence.

Your final report will need to be typed, double spaced with the default margins and font selection. You can choose to use any font size between 11 and 14. Your report should be no shorter than one page and no longer than two pages. Your report is due **Thursday, February 20** and your grade will be based on the following criteria:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Includes an attention-grabbing introduction that explains why you chose this saint
- \_\_\_\_\_ Report is organized into a logical sequence that guides the reader through saint's life
- \_\_\_\_\_ Author appears to be an expert on facts about his or her saint's life
- \_\_\_\_\_ Includes how this saint honored God
- \_\_\_\_\_ Includes circumstances under which one would make a special petition to this Saint
- \_\_\_\_\_ Report includes a thoughtful conclusion that adds new insight
- \_\_\_\_\_ Logical transitions create a seamless flow between paragraphs
- \_\_\_\_\_ Proper spelling and grammar conventions are used
- \_\_\_\_\_ Each of the formatting requirements listed above are met
- \_\_\_\_\_ Research sources are listed on the back of this scoring sheet (a minimum of two)
